INTRODUCTION

It has well been established that the dream to start this orphanage home had long lived in the minds of the founding fathers, they thought over it day in day out. They kept the dream alive as they strived to realize it.

Eventually the dream came true in the year 1989 (1409 A.H). It began very humbly as the founders rented some few rooms in the town centre to house the 60 orphans who had already been enrolled.

Afterwards, with the grace of Allah, an NGO by the name Organization of Islamic Heritage and Culture built for us six classes and a dining hall on the land acquired by the institution in iftin location.

This was later followed by another blessing in the year 1993 (1412 A.H) when another NGO by the name Islamic foundation came in handy building for us a dormitory with a capacity of 145 children and also took up the task of sponsoring 145 children among the Orphans. They also went ahead and built a Mosque for the centre that would handle a capacity of 160 persons. We are asking Allah to reward them immensely in this world and the hereafter.

In the following year, 1994 (1413 A.H) the Qatar Charity also came in handy by building three dormitories enough to handle 150 children. They also built the Administration office and also took up the responsibility of taking care of the 150 orphans. For this and other charity work we are praying that Allah rewards them immensely both in this world and the hereafter.

Unfortunately the centre suffered a huge setback in the year 2002 (1423 A.H) when some foundation was forced to cut short its support to the centre due to difficulties in funds. This event left us in a tight position not knowing how the children in our custody will live and further their studies.

That fateful event left us with no option other than sending all the children under the sponsorship of that foundation back to their homes as we could no longer give them their basic necessities.

Currently the orphanage centre is under financial crises with no funding received from any well wishers or organization. The current population of the orphans stands at 320 children, both boys and girls. They constitute of all the communities in Kenya with the majority coming from the North Eastern and the Coastal parts of Kenya where the Muslim population is high.

Despite the Orphanage Centre having serious financial constrains, it has never stopped providing the children with their necessities for life from food, shelter, clothing, medication, education requirements and many others.

This is in the Endeavour to try and fit in the shoes of the lost parents despite the fact that no human being can really fill the gaps left by the departed parents in terms of love, affection and

provision. This being the fact, come to think of it when that role is taken care of by a small and humble organization like Najah, it is indeed an uphill task for us.

The Education System

The orphanage centre has got a credible learning system aimed at creating a unique individual ready to serve the Muslim community and humanity at large in the most appropriate way while presenting a perfect example to the rest of the society. Our education is aimed at producing that rare character that is really required in the world currently. A character that would resemble that of our beloved prophet (s.a.w) and his magnificent companions. Our education system consists of the following categories and levels;

- 1) The Islamic studies category, which consists of three levels as follows;
 - a) Basic/ Primary level.
 - b) Intermediary level.
 - c) Secondary level (advanced level).

- 2) The second category constitutes the secular studies which constitutes of the primary level (Class 1-8) and secondary. (The 8-4-4 system of education).

PROBLEM STATEMENT

- 1) Establishment of income generating projects that would help the centre be self sustaining in future, this may include some football field building of rental houses and business premises, commercial farming e.t.c.
- 2) Fencing of the institution for protection purposes and safeguarding it from the risk of land grabbing.
- 3) Building of new classes rooms as well as expansion of the existing ones as they are very congested.
- 4) Expansion of the institution's dispensary, this will help the children access quick and better treatment and the community around the centre to enjoy treatment at a subsidized cost as well as helping in maintaining the health facility.
- 5) Provision of course books for both the religious and secular system.
- 6) Provision of a school bus, this would ease the transportation of children from one place to another.
- 7) Academic scholarships for students pursuing University education.
- 8) Financial support as the support we are getting now is far from being enough to sustain the needs of the institution.

JUSTIFICATION

With the construction of the seven sides football field the institution will gain an income that will cater for the following;

1. With possession in hand of such agreed project. The orphanage will be able of buying foodstuff, medicine for orphan treatment, paying for water bills, beddings such as pillows, mosquito nets beds and stationeries, renovating of premises dormitories and classes and constructing of more classes and dormitories.
2. The football field (Seven sided) will act as incoming generating activities in which the management will put a strategy plan layout in undertaking future activities such as educational trips, medical camp etc
3. This project will reduce the institution from suffering problems that hinders the smooth running of the day to day operation.
4. It will act as a diversion element to the young generation who might be engaging in drug abuse and other evils act to become active in physical fits activities by playing football regularly. This will help them grow healthier.
5. It develops and enlightens good perspective to the surrounding community. Since many friends keep on meeting in the field now and then for friendly matches.

SUSTAINABILITY

The Orphanage centre will take a full control of maintaining the project in a regular base to serve the purpose. Therefore, since this is one of the main income generating project that was made to serve orphans, the board of management will immensely have a deep concern of their well being.
